Parent Meetings – September 2016

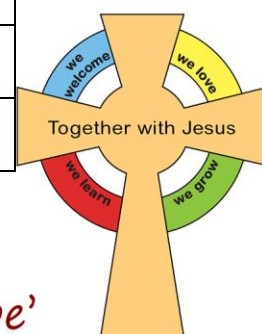

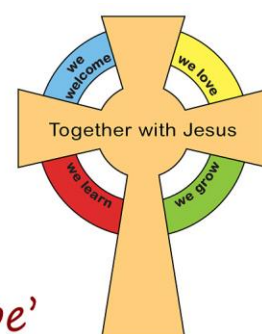
