## Message for Y6 Parents - Secondary School Admission for September 2016

Just to remind you, the Common Application Form **must** be completed on line.

If you attend St. Vincent's Church Father George will be available to sign forms on the following mornings between **10 o'clock and 12 noon**;

**Monday 5<sup>th</sup> October, Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> October, Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> October and Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October.**

There is no need to make an appointment on these days, just go to the Presbytery and he will be there between those times. If you worship in a different Parish you will need to find out what arrangements your Parish Priest has made.

Parents will need to produce their own Baptismal certificate for the Priest; this should be from at least one parent. If you do not have your Baptismal certificate at home, please contact the Parish where you were baptised. Father George will accept copies which have been scanned and emailed to him.

**St Vincent’s Day**

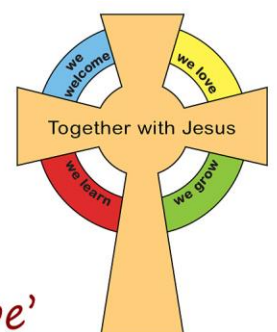
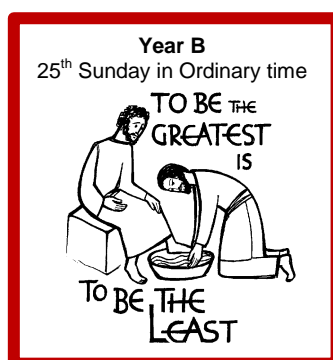
