**Head Boy and Head Girl**

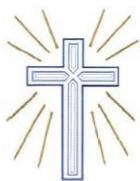

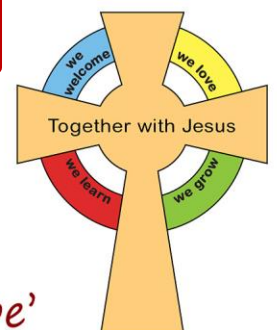
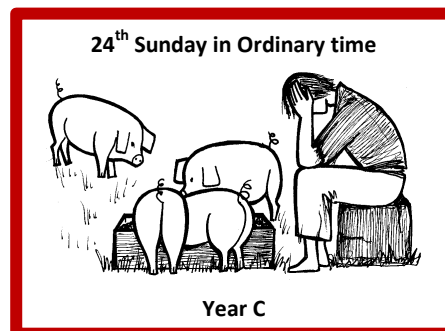
Please keep Mr Mugenyi (Josh our sports coach) in your prayers. Sadly his father passed away in Uganda on Wednesday.
