Prayer – make time to pray during lent, on your own or as a family.

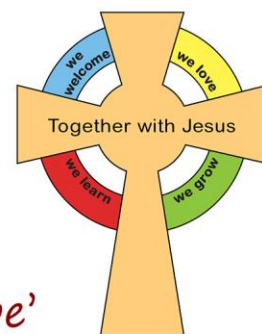
Fasting – not necessarily going without food, but perhaps fasting from TV or your computer, iPad, X Box, PS4 or Wii for a small amount of time each week.
