Basketball Tournament

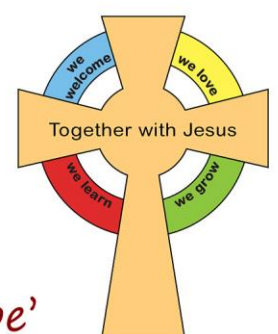
