Stubbers Event – Y6

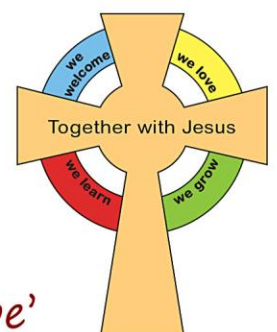
