Year 4 Visit

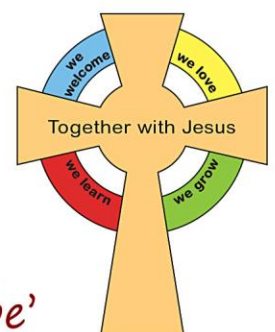
As part of their learning, Year 4 visited Valence House. They enjoyed outdoor Anglo-Saxon cooking and an excavation.

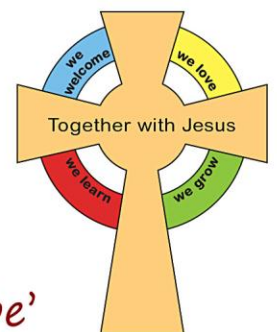

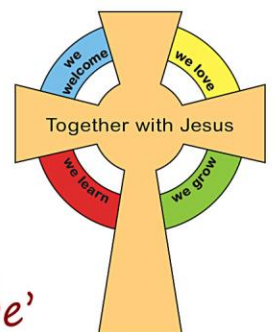
