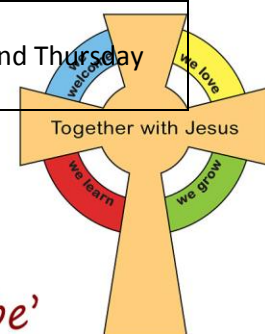
By registering for Pupil Premium could raise an extra £1320 for your child's school, to fund valuable support.

Year 6 Visit to Valence House

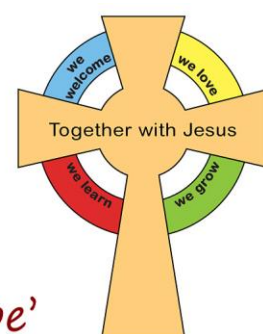
Well done to Year 6 for making such a good impression when they were out on their trip. I received a lovely email from the School's Library Service who are based there to compliment the children;
