*'It was an amazing trip because we learnt new information'. Tochi*

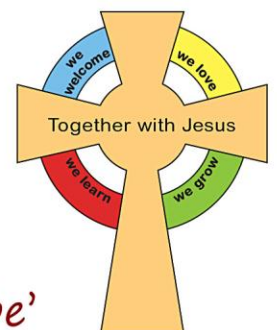


*'At All Saints we had lots of fun. We started the day off by studying English, then Art where we made papier mache fish and finally improvised drama'. Liam*

## First Communion Programme 2018/2019

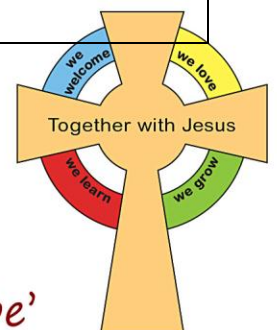

*'I personally liked it when we were taught about the dangers of electricity and were tested at the end'.(Paul)*



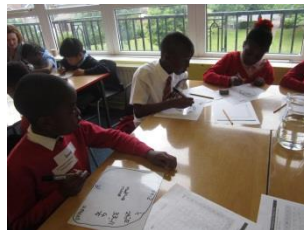
*'The junior citizen day was about being safe. I liked being tested by the 'strangers' and you had to work as a team'. (Jaylan)*

Yesterday 10 children from Year 3 and 4 met Mrs Hearne at Manor Junior School where they participated in a workshop run by an inspirational math's specialist.



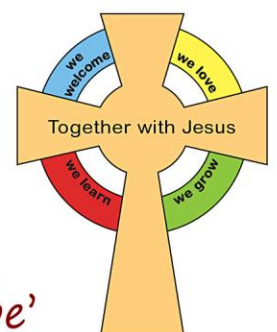
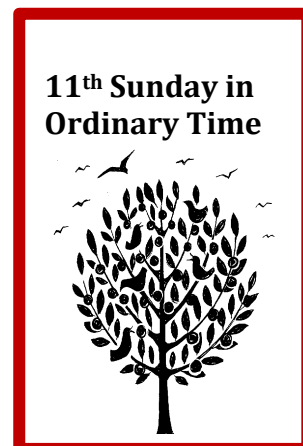
*'I enjoyed learning about mathematical clocks and designing a mathematical tablecloth'. Zoe- Marie*
