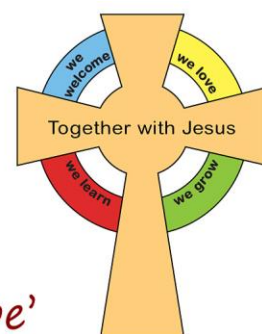
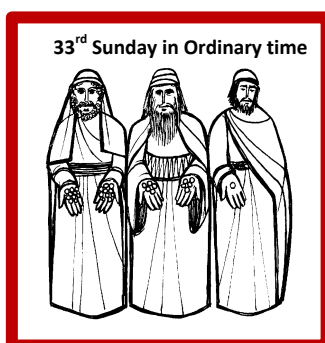
**Reading workshop**
