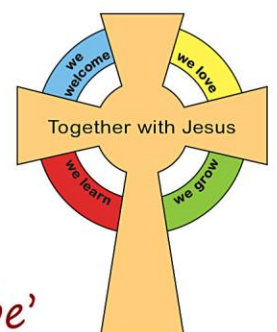

Farewell to Y6

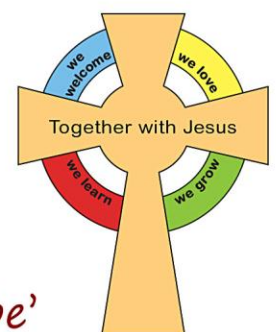
Year 6 have written their final thoughts about St Vincent's.....

We went to Stubbers and Breanna and I were sailing, we fell into the water and Breanna said we are going to die, I said no you are not I am. **Calum**

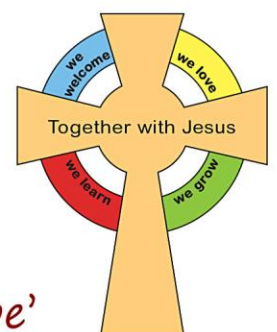
When we went to Stubbers me and Keyleigh tried to tip the boat over and we kept screaming. **Daniel**

At Fairplay House when everyone was asleep in the middle of the night I started eating their food. We had battles and wrecked Paul's bed. **Andrew**

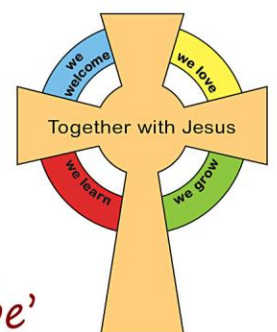

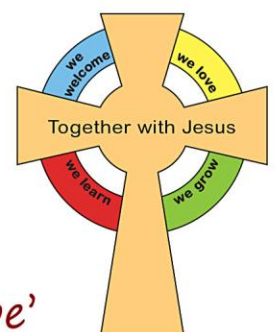

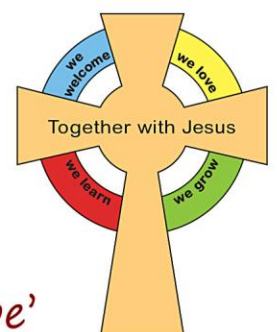
Prayer to End a School Year
