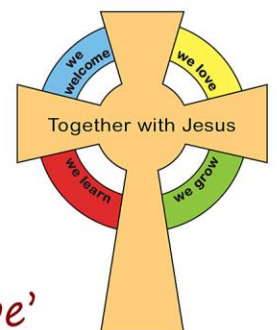
## Victim Support. Safer Homes Project – Barking & Dagenham

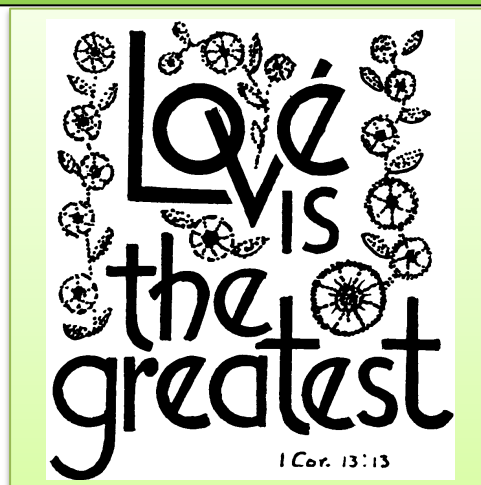

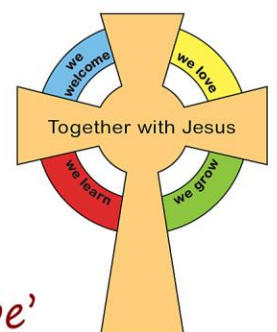
