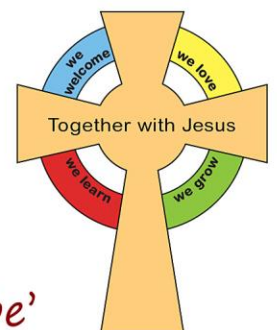

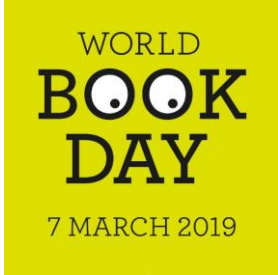

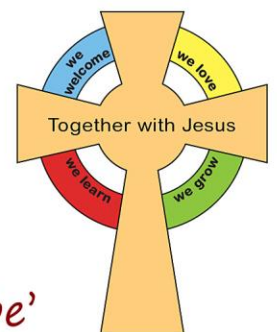
World Book Day

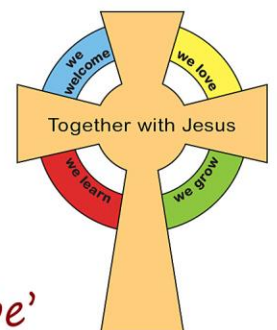
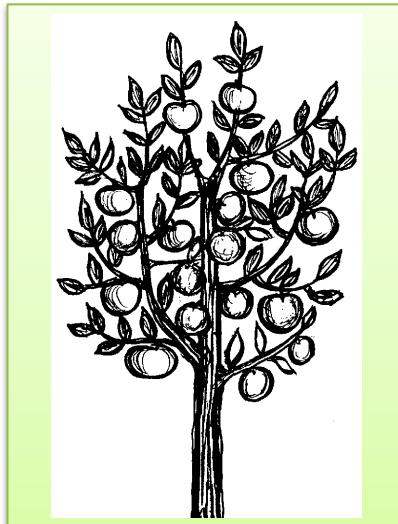
