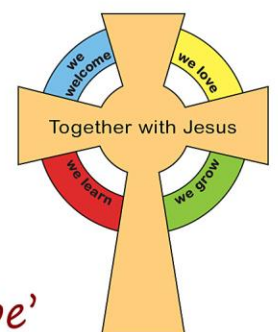
Welcome Miss O' Donnell and Mrs Ibrahim

Parentpay and Breakfast Club

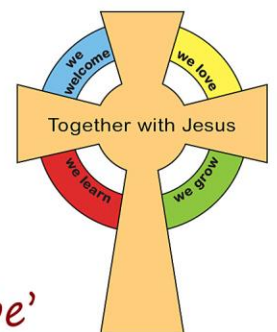

Karate

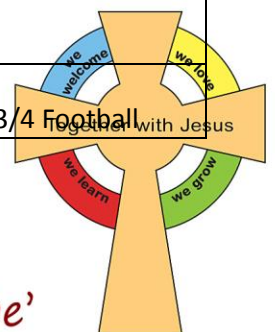
At the Karate Club this past week, the children received their KYU Grade certificate and appropriate coloured belt. Well done, boys and girls!

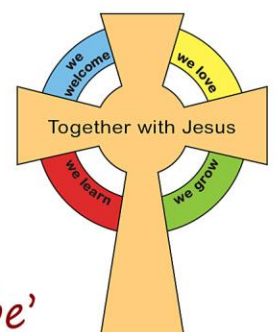
