## WORLD FOOD DAY!

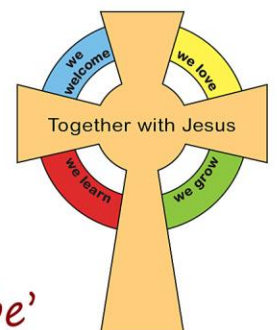

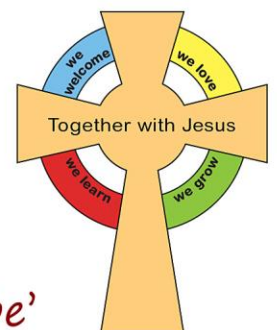

## **Year 6 trip to Valence House for a World War Two Day**

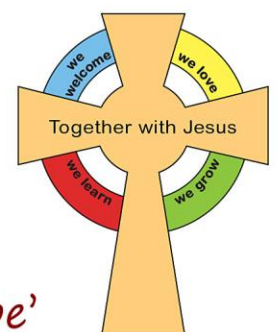


Year 6 visited Valence House on Tuesday. They found the trip enjoyable, interesting and informative.

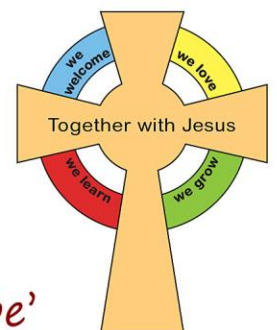
